The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 320-31-1-0 of the code is amended to read:

320-31. City Information Management Committee.

1. COMPOSITION. There is created a city information management committee consisting of [[40]]

Part 2. Section 320-31-1-k of the code is created to read:

k. The chief information officer. This member shall be the vice chair of the committee.

Part 3. Section 320-31-6 of the code is amended to read:

6. STAFFING. The city clerk's office shall provide staff support to the committee. ~~[[The chief information officer shall serve as its executive secretary.]]~~ The city attorney shall designate an assistant city attorney to be present at all meetings of the committee.
