Lisbon Ave which was authorized by Common Council Resolution File Number 001013 adopted on, November 28, 2000. T-Mobile succeeded to the interests of Voicestream PCS II Corporation following the execution of the lease.

Whereas, The Common Council adopted Resolution File Number 001013 on November 28, 2000 approving a lease agreement with Voicestream PCS II Corporation for the placement of personal communications services antennas at the Fire Station at 8814 W. Lisbon Avenue; and

Whereas, T-Mobile succeeded as tenant to the lease; and

Whereas, The Department of Administration, working with the City Attorney's Office, has negotiated an amendment to the lease agreement; and

Whereas, This amendment of the lease agreement between the City and T-Mobile for the placement of personal communications services antennas at the Fire Station at 8814 W. Lisbon Avenue, allows T-Mobile to upgrade its facilities; and
