Resolution relative to acceptance and funding of a 2016/17 ShotSpotter Program grant.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to accept and fund a ShotSpotter Program grant from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice (DOJ), in the amount of \$175,000 with a city share of \$0, and a grantor share of \$175,000. The purpose of this grant is to assist in the funding of the City's ShotSpotter Ssystem.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 7/01/16 to 6/30/17 would cost \$175,000 of which \$0 (0%) would be provided by the city and \$175,000 (100%) would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Police Department shall accept and fund this grant for the specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
