Part 1. Part 1, Section 2 of ordinance File Number 170680 relative to rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service is hereby amended as follows (Effective Pay Period 23, 2017 - November 5, 2017):

Under Pay Range 2LX, add the titles "ERS Database Administrator (3)", "ERS Server Administrator (3)", and "ERS Software Developer (3)"; and add footnote "(3)" to read as follows:

"(3) Recruitment at any point in the range with DER approval."

Part 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
