Resolution authorizing a sidewalk replacement project in the eighth aldermanic district. To provide the necessary authority for sidewalk repairs in the eighth aldermanic district. Whereas, It is necessary and in the public interest to replace those sidewalk stones which are cracked, broken, out of grade or otherwise a hazard to pedestrians; and

Whereas, It is proposed that sidewalk replacement work be done in the following locations at the indicated cost:

Area bounded by West Greenfield Avenue, South Layton Boulevard, West Burnham Street and South 35th Street in the eighth (8th) aldermanic district ST230090134; and

Whereas, Funds have been encumbered and thus set aside for the proposed public improvement; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Commissioner of Public Works be, and is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to do the above described sidewalk replacement work and the City Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$400,000.00 from Account No. 0333-4926-ST230090000 and \$300,000.00 from Account No. 0330-4926-ST230090000 which is available for sub-accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper City Departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting properties, and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the
