Resolution authorizing acceptance of funding for an ATF Milwaukee Firearms/Violent Crimes Impact Team Task Force grant.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to funding for an ATF Milwaukee Firearms/Violent Crimes Impact Team Task Force from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, in the amount of \$90,000.00, with no City match. The purpose of this grant is to fund overtime expenses in order to provide resources to assist the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives in joint law enforcement operations.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for funding from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from December 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018 would cost \$90,000.00 of which 100% would be provided by the grantor; now therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Police Department is authorized to accept this grant without further approval unless its terms change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it
