THE CHAIR

A substitute resolution to authorizing the Department of Employee Relations to extend the current contract with Health E(fx) for the City's Affordable Care Act reporting.

This resolution authorizes the Department of Employee Relations (DER) to extend the current contract with Health E(fx) for three years.

Whereas, The City is required to comply with various aspects of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) regulations including reporting requirements regarding members who receive health benefits during a calendar year, and

Whereas, The City is required to monitor and track health benefits coverage for members and dependents annually; and

Whereas, The City is required to annually issue required IRS forms to the member and the IRS; and

Whereas Health E(fx) understands the complexities of managing ACA compliance and reporting for organizations that have self-administered health benefit plans and a multifaceted workforce; and

Whereas, Health E(fx) is a valuable partner in assisting the City with ACA reporting challenges and continues to provide exceptional service to the City; and

Whereas, Health E(fx) has agreed to flat administration fees for the first year of the extension and 2% increase for the following two years, now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the DER is authorized to extend the current contract with Health E(fx) for three years until December 31, 2021.
