Whereas, Using NSP funding, MNRC acquired approximately 75 foreclosed units for redevelopment efforts, including homebuyer acquisition, developer acquisition/rehab and

Whereas, MNRC owns ten vacant lots, as described in the Land Disposition Report, which have achieved the proposed disposition strategy of demolition/blight elimination; and

Whereas, HUD is requiring NSP grant recipients to close out remaining NSP grant projects; and

Whereas, DCD, on behalf of the City, currently manages, maintains and disposes of vacant lots under City ownership; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Land Disposition Report, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File, is approved and that the appropriate City officials are authorized to accept title to ten vacant lots from MNRC and to maintain the lots and dispose of them consistent with the City's standard disposition practices; and, be it
