This ordinance increases various fees and forfeitures, effective January 1, 2019. The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 81-6-1 to 3 of the code is amended to read:

## 81-6. Service Charges for Appraisal and Inspection.

- **1.** NEW CONSTRUCTION.
- a. One-family: [[<del>\$247</del>]] >><u>\$259</u><<.
- b. Two-family: [[<del>\$373</del>]] >><u>\$391</u><<.
- c. Multi-family: [[\$441]] >><u>\$463</u><< plus [[\$110]] >><u>\$115</u><< per unit over 2 units.
- d. Commercial, industrial or public: \$0.05 per square foot, with a minimum charge of [[\$545]] >> \$572

<<.

#### 2. ALTERATIONS AND ADDITIONS.

a. Residential: [[0.36%]] >> 0.37% << of construction cost, with a minimum charge of [[\$12]] >> \$13 <<.b. Commercial: [[0.36%]] >> 0.37% <<% of construction cost, with a minimum charge of [[\$22]] >> \$23 <<.

c. Siding, deck, garage, air conditioning, fireplace or razing: [[<del>\$17</del>]] >><u>\$18</u><<. (See s. 307-6.)

- **3.** PLUMBING.
- a. Residential: [[<del>27%</del>]] >><u>28%</u><< of the plumbing permit cost imposed under s. 200-33-43.
- b. Commercial: [[<del>27%</del>]] >><u>28%</u><< of the plumbing permit cost imposed under s. 200-33-43.

Part 2. Section 81-51.5 of the code is amended to read:

**81-51.5 Extra Garbage Cart Charge.** The extra garbage cart charge shall be [[\$15]] >><u>\$17</u><< per quarter for each extra garbage cart provided under s. 79-4-1.3.

Part 3. Section 200-24-1.5-f-5 of the code is amended to read:

#### 200-24. Permits Required.

**1.5.** EXCEPTIONS. No permit shall be required for:

f-5. Replacement of unlimited quantities of roof covering or siding for one- and 2-family dwellings, and replacement of [[100]] >> 1,000 << square feet or >> 25% << [[less]] of roof covering >>, whichever is less << in all other use groups.

Part 4. Section 200-33-1-b, 2-a, b-1 and 2, b-3-a and b, and d of the code is amended to read:

#### 200-33- Fees.

**1**. AIR AND SUBTERRANEAN SPACE.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each air and subterranean space lease.

**2.** ALTERATIONS AND REPAIRS.

a. The fee for all alterations, remodeling, repairs and repairing fire damage to all buildings, structures and equipment shall be computed at [[<del>1.2%</del>]] >>1.3%<< of the cost of construction.

b-1. The minimum fee for one and 2- family dwellings and accessory structures shall be [[\$60]] >>\$65 <<.

b-2. The minimum fee for all other structures and buildings shall be [[\$80]] >> \$85 <<.

b-3-a. One- and 2-family dwellings and accessory buildings: [[\$60]] >> \$65 <<.

b-3-b. All other buildings and structures: [[\$80]] >> \$85 <<.

d. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each alteration or repair.

Part 5. Section 200-33-4 of the code is amended to read:

#### 4. AWNINGS.

a. The permit fee for the erection of fixed, movable and fabric- covered stationary awnings projecting beyond the street line shall be computed at [[1.2%]] >> 1.3% << of the cost of construction.

b. The minimum fee shall be [[\$60]] >> \$65 << per awning.

c. The fee for recovering or alterations to existing awnings shall be 60% of the fee calculated under

par. a, except that the minimum fee shall be [[\$60]] >> \$65 <<.

d. There shall be a processing fee of [[<del>\$6</del>]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each permit issued.

Part 6. Section 200-33-5-a-1-a to c, b-1, c, d-2 and 3, e and h of the code is amended to read:

#### **5.** BUILDING PERMITS.

a. Commercial Buildings and Residential Buildings Containing 3 or More Units, New Construction and Additions.

a-1-a. Residential buildings containing 3 or more units: [[\$0.34]] >> \$0.36 << per square foot.

a-1-b. Industrial and manufacturing buildings: [[<del>\$0.28</del>]] >><u>\$0.30</u><< per square foot.

a-1-c. All other commercial buildings: [[<del>\$0.32</del>]] >><u>\$0.34</u><< per square foot.

b. Dwellings, New Construction and Additions.

b-1. The fee for all one-and 2-family dwellings shall be computed at [[<del>\$0.3</del>4]] >><u>\$0.36 per</u><< square foot, using the definition set forth in s. 200-08-86.2.

c. Structures Accessory to One- and 2-family Dwellings. c-1. The fee for garages and other structures of more than 150 square feet in area accessory to one- and 2-family dwellings shall be computed at [[\$0.22]] >>\$0.25<< per square foot of area. The minimum fee shall be [[\$60]] >>\$65<<. c-2. The fee for sheds and other structures accessory to one- and 2-family dwellings and not more than 150 square feet in area shall be [[\$60]] >>\$65<<.

d. Footing and Foundation Permits.

d-2. The minimum fee for one- and 2-family dwellings and accessory structures shall be [[<del>\$200</del>]] > <u>\$250</u><<.

d-3. The minimum fee for all other buildings and structures shall be [[\$260]] >>\$275<<.

e. Odd Structures. The fee for permanent odd structures, such as parking lots, reviewing stands and tank towers or additions thereto shall be computed at [[1.2%]] >> 1.3% << of the cost of construction. The minimum fee shall be [[\$60]] >> \$65 <<.

h. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each type of building or structure permit issued under this subsection.

Part 7. Section 200-33-6 of the code is amended to read:

#### 6. CANOPIES.

a. The permit fee for hoods, canopies, and marquees projecting, and roofed sidewalks beyond a street line shall be computed at [[<del>1.2%</del>]] >><u>1.3%</u><< of the cost of construction.

b. The minimum fee shall be [[<del>\$60</del>]] >><u>\$65</u><<

c. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 8. Section 200-33-8.5-a-1 and 2, and b to d of the code is amended to read:

### **8.5.** CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY.

a. Certificates of Occupancy.

a-1. The required fee for certificates of occupancy in existing buildings or parts thereof with gross areas of less than 10,000 square feet open lots, outdoor storage and outdoor circuses shall be [[225]] >>250<<.

a-2. The required fee for certificates of occupancy in existing buildings or parts thereof with gross areas of 10,000 square feet or more shall be [[\$425]] >><u>\$450</u><<.

b. Conditional Certificate of Occupancy. The application fee for a conditional certificate of occupancy shall be [[\$150]] >> \$250 <<. This fee shall be payable at the time the application is submitted to the department.

c. Temporary Certificate of Occupancy. c-1. If issued by the department of neighborhood services, the fee for a temporary certificate of occupancy for buildings with gross area of 10,000 square feet or less shall be [[\$100]] >>\$250<<.

c-2. The fee for a temporary certificate of occupancy for buildings with gross area of greater than 10,000 square feet shall be [[\$150]] >>\$250<.

d. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each certificate of occupancy.

Part 9. Section 200-33-9-b of the code is amended to read:

#### 9. CONDITIONAL PERMIT.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each conditional permit.

Part 10. Section 200-33-11 of the code is repealed and recreated to read:

#### **11.** ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS AND REPAIRS.

Electrical repairs involving the replacement of a single existing light fixture, convenience outlet or switch, which do not involve changes to existing wiring, change of a circuit or increase in size of load, can be made without permit, providing these repairs do not conflict with any regulation of this code. The following fees shall be collected when permits are submitted for commercial electrical installation or repair, or for residential remodeling projects that involve any of the following electrical installations or repairs:

a. Air conditioner outlet for one and 2- family dwelling units: \$20.

b-1. Air conditioner other than one and 2-family dwellings: \$35 minimum.

b-2. Air conditioning with heat or roof top unit: \$50.

- c. Capacitor or converter: \$50.
- d. Dimmer: \$5.
- e. Dishwasher: \$15.
- f. Dryer (electric) outlet: \$15.
- g. Feeder:
- g-1. Up to 400 amps: \$40.
- g-2. 401-600 amps: \$100.
- g-3. 601-800 amps: \$140.
- g-4. 801-1000 amps: \$180.
- g-5. Over 1000 amps: \$220.
- g-6. Feeder over 600 volts: \$250.
- g-7. Feeder switch located at meter main enclosure: \$30.
- h. Fire alarm system:
- h-1. Fire alarm panel: \$75.
- h-2 Fire alarm initiating and indicating device: \$7.
- h-3. Fire pump: \$150.
- h-4. Fire pump controller: \$75.
- i. Furnace with motor: \$15.

yr. There shall be a processing fee of \$8 for each electrical installation or repair permit issued.

Part 11. Section 200-33-13-1-c and e of the code is amended to read:

#### **13**. ELEVATORS.

c. Certificate of Operation. The fee for a certificate of operation shall be [[\$75]] >><u>\$100</u><<.

d. Construction Permit Fees.

d-1. New Installation. The fees for permits required by this subsection shall be charged at the rate of  $[[\frac{1.5\%}{1.6\%}] >> \frac{1.6\%}{1.6\%} <<$ of the total cost of installation, with a minimum permit fee of \$800 for a traction elevator, other driving machines, escalator or moving walk. There shall be a minimum permit fee of \$720 for a hydraulic elevator and a minimum permit fee of \$640 for a dumbwaiter, platform lift, stair chair lift or special application elevator.

d-2. Application, Repairs and Remodeling. The fees for the review of alteration, repairs or remodeling of such existing devises by this paragraph shall be charged at the rate of [[1.5%]] >> 1.6% << of the total cost of installation, with a minimum permit fee of \$400 for a traction elevator, other elevator driver machines, an escalator or a moving sidewalk. There shall be a minimum permit fee of \$360 for a hydraulic elevator, a minimum permit fee of \$320 for a dumbwaiter, platform lift, stair chair lift, or special application elevator.

e. Repair Permit Fees. The fees for installation or alteration permits required by s. SPS 302-15, Wis. Adm. Code, shall be charged at the rate of [[1.5%]] >> 1.6% << of the total cost of repair, with a minimum fee of [[\$60]] >> \$65 <<.

Part 12. Section 200-33-13.5-a-1, b and c of the code is amended to read:

### 13.5. EROSION CONTROL.

a-1. One- and 2- family lots: [[<del>\$150</del>]] >><u>\$175</u><< per lot.

b-1. The plan examination fee for erosion control measures for sites less than one acre shall be [[ <u>\$110</u>]] >><u>\$125</u><<.

b-2. The plan examination fee for erosion control measures for all other sites shall be [[\$165]] >><u>\$175</u> <<.

a. The permit fee for the erection of fire escapes shall be computed at [[<del>1.2%</del>]] >><u>1.3%</u><< of the cost of construction with a minimum fee of [[<del>\$60</del>]] >><u>\$65</u><<.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each fire escape permit issued.

Part 15. Section 200-33-19-a and c of the code is amended to read:

#### **19.** FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS OR SOLIDS, VAULT OR ROOM.

a. The permit fee for the installation or alteration of vaults or rooms in any building for the storage or use of flammable solids, liquids or other combustible material shall be computed at the rate of [[1.2%]] >>1.3%<< of the cost or fraction thereof. The minimum fee shall be [[60]] >>>565<<. c. There shall be processing fee of [[60]] >>8<< for each permit issued.

Part 16. Section 200-33-20-b of the code is amended to read:

20. FLOOD PLAIN FILL PERMIT.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each flood plain fill permit issued.

Part 17. Section 200-33-21-b of the code is amended to read:

**21.** FLOOD PLAIN LOCATION CERTIFICATE.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >><u>\$8</u><< for each flood plain location certificate issued.

Part 18. Section 200-33-22-b of the code is amended to read:

#### 22. GRANDSTANDS.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 19. Section 200-33-23-a-1 to 3 and 6, c to g, j and L of the code is amended to read:

#### **23.** HEATING AND VENTILATING SYSTEMS.

a. Heating and Ventilating.

a-1. Heating, incinerator units and wood-burning appliances: [[\$50]] >> \$55 << per unit not exceeding 150,000 BTUs of input. For each additional 50,000 BTUs or fraction thereof, an additional fee of [[\$10]] >> \$11 << shall be charged.

a-2. Heating and air conditioning distribution systems: [[\$1.90]] >> \$2 << per 100 square feet of conditioned area. The minimum fee shall be [[\$40]] >> \$50 <<.

c. Boilers. The permit fee for the installation or replacement of a boiler shall be [[\$50]] >>\$55<< per unit not exceeding 150,000 BTUs of input. For each additional 50,000 BTUs or fraction thereof, an additional fee of [[\$10]] >>\$11<< shall be charged.

d. Unfired Pressure Vessels. The permit fee for the installation of an unfired pressure vessel shall be [[\$50]] >> \$55 << per vessel.

e. Power Piping. The permit fee for the installation of power piping shall be [[\$15]] >><u>\$16</u><< per 100

feet of piping. The minimum fee shall be [[\$50]] >> \$55 <<.

f. Repairs. The permit fee for repairs of boilers and pressure vessels shall be [[\$40]] >> \$55 <<.

g. Electronic Monitoring. The permit fee for the installation of electronic monitoring shall be computed at [[\$100]] >><u>\$105</u><< for each boiler.

j. Hydrostatic tests for boilers and unfired pressure vessels: [[\$110]] >>\$120<<.

L. Processing Fee. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 20. Section 200-33-24 of the code is amended to read:

24. HEATING FROM CENTRAL OR DISTRICT SYSTEM.

a. The permit fee for the installation of a heating system in any building supplied by a central or district heating system shall be [[\$50]] >> \$55 << per heating system b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$61]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 21. Section 200-33-28-b of the code is amended to read:

**28.** MORE THAN ONE OCCUPANCY.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << 6 for each permit issued.

Part 22. Section 200-33-29-b of the code is amended to read:

**29.** MOTOR VEHICLE EXHIBITION.

b. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 23. Section 200-33-30-c of the code is amended to read:

c. There shall be a processing fee of [[\$6]] >> \$8 << for each permit issued.

Part 24. Section 200-33-34-b of the code is amended to read:
