## THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing the Milwaukee Police Department to enter into a 2018/19 Intergovernmental Truancy Abatement and Burglary Suppression (TABS) agreement for additional law enforcement services with the Milwaukee Board of School Directors.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to enter into a 2018/19 Intergovernmental Truancy Abatement and Burglary Suppression program agreement with the Milwaukee Public Schools, in the amount of \$435,000.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible to enter into an agreement with the Milwaukee Board of School Directors for a TABS program; and

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee may enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with the Milwaukee Board of School Directors; and

Whereas, The Police Department may enter into agreements exceeding \$50,000 that have been approved by the Chief of Police as indicated in Section 312-26, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and

Whereas, The period of this agreement from 08/13/18 to 5/24/19 would fund \$435,000 towards the salaries, fringe benefits, indirect costs and overtime of six officers; now, therefore, be it
