Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the APHL/LSIP, for the purpose of targeting improvements to the Local Public Health Laboratory (LPHL) system in Milwaukee as identified in our L-SIP Assessment conducted in May 2018.

Whereas, The continued operation of this grant program from 03.01.2019 to 06.30.2019 would cost \$10,000; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application of this grant from the APHL/LSIP is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it
