Resolution authorizing acceptance and funding the 2019-20 Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to accept an Anti-Heroin Task Force Grant from the U.S Department of Justice through the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice in the amount of \$60,000.00 with a city share of \$-0- and a grantor share of \$60,000.00. The purpose of this grant is to fund overtime expenses related to narcotics investigations which focus on the illicit trafficking of opiates, heroin, or both.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for an Anti-Heroin Task Force grant from the United States Department of Justice through the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 1/01/19 to 12/31/2020 would cost \$60,000, of which 100% would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Police Department is authorized to accept this grant without further approval unless its terms change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2019 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the project titled: Anti-Heroin Task Force
