Whereas, the volume of litter has increase significantly over the last few years; and

Whereas, the level of need has increased beyond what the private sector can sustain; and

Whereas, there is significant interest from the business community for the beautification of many areas near and around the freeway system; and

Whereas, the City will benefit by cooperatively investigating new ways of using existing financial and contractual tools and pilot new tools that will result in more efficient processes, generation of new sources of
