A substitute ordinance relating to the membership of the safety and civic commission.

This ordinance clarifies that each member of the safety and civic commission appointed by a common council member shall be a resident of the aldermanic district of the appointing council member.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 320-27-1-0 and b of the code is amended to read:

320-27. Safety and Civic Commission.

1. CREATION. There is created a safety and civic commission comprised of the following [[, all of whom shall live in the city]]:

b. Fifteen members, one appointed by the alderman or alderwoman of each aldermanic district >><u>who is a resident of that aldermanic district</u><<, subject to confirmation by the common council.

Initially, members from districts 1 through 3 shall be appointed to a three-year term; members from districts 4 through 9 shall be appointed to a two-year term; and members from districts 10 through 15 shall be appointed to a one-year term. Subsequent appointments and reappointments shall be for three-year terms.
