Resolution relative to acceptance and funding of a 2018/19 Homeland Security/Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC) Public Health Intelligence Threat Analyst grant.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to accept and fund a Homeland Security STAC Public Health Intelligence Threat Analyst grant from the U.S. Department of Justice through the State of Wisconsin, Department of Military Affairs (DMA), in the amount of \$40,000 with a city share of \$0, and a grantor share of \$40,000. The purpose of this funding is to fund the contracted services of a Medical Threat Intelligence Analyst who will work with the STAC, Southeast WI Healthcare Emergency Readiness Coalition (HERC), public health, healthcare, and emergency management partners to provide real-time tactical, operational, and strategic medical information to regional and state stakeholders.

Whereas, Under CFDA 97.067, the City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice through the State of Wisconsin DMA; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 9/16/19 to 8/30/20 would cost \$40,000 of which \$0 (0%) would be provided by the city and \$40,000 (100%) would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Police Department shall accept

this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That, the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2019 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects, the following amount for the program titled: HS-WEM/STAC Public Health Intelligence Threat Analyst Grant.

2. Create the necessary Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project/Grant levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amount required under the grant agreement;

3. Establish the necessary City Share Project Values; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted for the Milwaukee Police Department which is authorized to:

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Transfer funds within the project budget as long as the amount expended for each specific purpose does not exceed the amount authorized by the budget by 10 percent.
