Whereas, The claimants, Christopher, Christina, and Isabella Marshall, through their attorneys, Warshafsky, Rotter, Tarnoff & Bloch, S.C., have filed claims for damages against the City of Milwaukee for injuries and damages incurred on August 12, 2017 as a result of a police dog bite of Isabella Marshall; and

Whereas, The claimants have agreed to settle their claims in the total amount of \$115,000; and

Whereas, The City Attorney recommends and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee deems it expeditious and just to pay these claims; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the proper City officials be and are hereby authorized and directed to issue a City check in the amount of \$85,000 payable to the order of Pacific Life & Annuity Services, Inc. and to issue a City check in the amount of \$30,000 payable to the order of Warshafsky, Rotter, Tarnoff & Bloch, S.C. Trust Account in full and final settlement of said claims, on receipt of a Release of Claims, approved as to form and execution by the City Attorney, said amount to be charged to the Damages and Claims Fund, Account No. 636505, Fund No. 0001,
