for tenant improvements, façade improvements, new signage or other expenses (the "Business Attraction/Retention Fund"); and

Whereas, Broken Egg, LLC ("Owner") owns Broken Egg Family Restaurant located at 10843 West Park Place (the "Property"), which is located within the District, and has renovated the Property, a formerly vacant 4,990 square foot space, into a family style restaurant; and

Whereas, In File No. 190551, the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee approved a signage grant to the Owner in the amount up to \$2,010.80 for the installation of signage at the Property; and

Whereas, To complete its renovation of the Property, Owner has applied for a grant in an amount up to \$2,265.00 to pay for a portion of the total costs, estimated at \$4,530.00, for façade enhancement work at the Property; and

Whereas, The Redevelopment Authority of the City of Milwaukee conducted a public hearing on the proposed Project and expenditure and recommended that the term sheet for this Project be approved and submitted such recommendation to the Common Council for approval along with the Term Sheet, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council file; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Property City officials are directed to enter into a Grant Agreement for the purposes of implementing the Project on terms substantially in accordance with the Term Sheet; and, be it
