Resolution approving the submission of the Recovery Plan to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee Board of Commissioners received a letter from Shirley Wong, Director Milwaukee Office of Public Housing at U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on September 10, 2019 notifying them that the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee was designated as substandard with an overall score of 61 (of 100) for the fiscal year ending 12/31/2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners/Governing body of the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee was requested to take immediate action to identify the source(s) of the performance deficiencies and develop and implement a plan to recover its PHAS score and ensure long-term sustainability at an acceptable level of performance; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee created a Recovery Plan detailing the list of actions and solutions to recover its performance for long-term sustainability in the areas of physical and management deficiencies; and NOW THEREFORE BE IT.

RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee to submit the proposed Recovery Plan to HUD for review and approval; and NOW THEREFORE BE IT,

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee may update the recovery plan action items and details as needed to best ensure long-term sustainability of recovery efforts.
