Whereas, The 2020 Adopted City Budget contains a footnote (Footnote #15), directing the Department of City Development to present a plan to increase participation and create successful outcomes for the City's Earn & Learn program; and

Whereas, A resolution is required to effectuate the intent of this footnote; and

Whereas, The Earn & Lean program's mission is to assist young people from Milwaukee in making a successful transition from adolescence into adulthood by developing job skills while gaining authentic work experience opportunities; and

Whereas, The Earn & Lean program is the largest single summer youth employment program in the City of Milwaukee, providing opportunities for around 1,000 teens every summer; and
