This resolution authorizes the MHD Health Department to accept \$10,000 from APHL to move forward with next steps in its Laboratory System Improvement Program (L-SIP) by conducting a Laboratory Career Exploration Day in order to target improving the performance of Milwaukee’s Local Public Health Laboratory (LPHL) system in the area of workforce development.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the APHL/LSIP, for the purpose of conducting a Laboratory Career Exploration Day in order to target improving the performance of Milwaukee’s Local Public Health Laboratory (LPHL) system in the area of workforce development.

Whereas, The continued operation of this grant program from 12.09.2019 to 06.30.2020 would cost \$10,000; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application of this grant from the APHL/LSIP is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it
