THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing and directing a transfer of funds from the Capital Improvements-Advance Planning Fund to a subaccount for comprehensive planning, land use and zoning analysis, GIS mapping, and other related administrative activities.

This resolution transfers \$85,000 in funds from the Capital Improvements-Advance Planning accounts into a subaccount to provide for graduate internships, GIS related licensing and activities, as well as other miscellaneous expenses as the need arises.

Whereas, The Department of City Development (“DCD”) Planning Division carries out ongoing land use and zoning analysis, citywide comprehensive planning, and GIS mapping and data analysis activities; and

Whereas, Technical assistance in these planning activities has often been augmented by outside consultants and graduate interns; and

Whereas, Funds are necessary to provide for such consultant services and graduate interns as the need arises; and

Whereas, Funds are also necessary for additional administrative activities to support ongoing planning efforts including graphic design, community engagement, and mapping and data analysis; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the City Comptroller is directed to transfer the amount of \$85,000 from the 2020 Capital Improvements-Advance Planning Fund, Account No. 1910-UR01220000A, to Account No. 1910-UR01211100 to be used by DCD, as the need may arise, to provide technical support and administrative costs; and, be it

Further Resolved, That DCD is authorized to enter into such contracts and agreements as necessary to accomplish the intent and purpose of this resolution.
