THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Maintenance Covenant document between the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District requiring the City of Milwaukee to keep, preserve, and maintain the green infrastructure located in the medians of South 76<sup>th</sup> Street between West Waterford Avenue and West Honey Creek Drive, in the 11<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District.

This original resolution authorizes the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Maintenance Covenant document titled Green Infrastructure Ten-Year Maintenance Covenant for green infrastructure located in the medians of South 76<sup>th</sup> Street between West Waterford Avenue and West Honey Creek Drive, in the 11<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District.

Whereas, Stormwater pollution control is an important component of the City of Milwaukee's (City) storm water management regulations and the City's stormwater permit with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR); and

Whereas, Nonpoint sources such as roadways have been recognized as the primary source of environmental pollution by discharging polluted runoff directly into the local streams and water bodies, threatening natural habitat and species; and

Whereas, In 2018, the City was awarded Green Infrastructure Funding from Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD); and

Whereas, The funds allowed green infrastructure consisting of bioswales to be installed in the medians of South 76<sup>th</sup> Street between West Waterford Avenue and West Honey Creek Drive; and

Whereas, The agreement for said funding stipulated that the City shall execute a maintenance covenant in favor of MMSD; and

Whereas, MMSD has drafted said covenant which shall be in effect for a period of ten years; now therefore, be it;

Resolved, That the Commissioner of Public Works is authorized to execute Green Infrastructure Ten-Year Maintenance Covenant in favor of Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District for the maintenance of green infrastructure located in the medians of South 76<sup>th</sup> Street between West Waterford Avenue and West Honey Creek Drive, said Covenant being attached to this Common Council Resolution File Number 200924 and incorporated in this resolution by reference as though set forth in full.
