Resolution approving an award of contract to Argus Technical Services (Milwaukee, WI) to provide maintenance employee staffing for the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee in the of amount of \$750,000

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee (HACM) solicited proposals by Official Notice No. 58007 on November 4 and November 11, 2020 to provide Maintenance Employee Staffing for the HACM; and

WHEREAS, two proposals were received by the deadline of 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, after careful review of the proposals received, staff of the HACM recommends that Argus Technical Services submitted the most responsive proposal and is the best qualified to undertake such Maintenance Employee Staffing for the HACM; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee that they be and hereby authorize and approve accepting the proposal of and entering into a contract with Argus Technical Services, for Maintenance Employee Staffing for the HACM, for approximately \$750,000 per year, with the option to extend for an additional four-one year terms upon mutual consent of both parties; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds for these services will come from various funding sources; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proper officers of the HACM be and hereby are authorized and directed to properly execute said contract for and on behalf of the HACM; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all of above is contingent upon receiving the approval of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, if required; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that all acts previously performed, relative to this matter, by the Commissioners and the Secretary-Executive Director of the HACM, be and hereby are approved, ratified, and confirmed in all respects.
