 Will not cause a substantial relocation of traffic facilities.
 Will not increase the land coverage of buildings and parking areas.
 Will not increase the gross floor area of buildings or the number of dwelling units.
 Will not reduce the amount of approved open space, landscaping or screening; and, be it
