Substitute resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of the 2021 Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Project E (Emerging Issues): Strengthening Public Health Laboratory (PHL) Preparedness grant from the Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health (DHS/DPH).

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept and fund the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) Project E (Emerging Issues): Strengthening Public Health Laboratory (PHL) Preparedness Grant from the Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health in the amount of \$500,000 (100%) grantor share with no city match. The purpose of the grant is to focus on strategies to strengthen surveillance, detection, and preparedness through the Laboratory Response Network (LRN) and at CDC.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health to provide public health testing and consultative services; and

Whereas, The continued operation of this grant program from 08.01.2021 to 12.15.2021 would cost \$500,000 comprised of \$500,000 (100%) grantor share; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application of this grant from the DHS/DPH

is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant parent of the 2021 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the program titled Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity Grant:

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund - Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amount required under the grant agreement; and, be it

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date; and
- 2. Expend from the 2021 grant budget for trainings;
- 3. Expend from the 2021 grant budget funds for specific items of equipment; and
- 4. Enter into subcontracts and leases as detailed in the grant budget; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Common Council directs that the 2021 Positions Ordinance C.C. File Number 200537, should be amended as follows:
