Substitute resolution relative to the acceptance and funding of the 2020 -2021 Upper Midwest Regional Accelerators for Genomic Surveillance Grant from the Rockefeller Foundation and University of Wisconsin-Madison.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept and fund the 2021 - 2021 Upper Midwest Regional Accelerators for Genomic Surveillance Grant from Rockefeller Foundation and University of Wisconsin-Madison in the amount of \$25,846 100% grantor share with no city match. The purpose of the grant is to focus on conducting genomic surveillance for SARS-CoV-2 in the school-aged children population to better understand the emergence and spread of SARS-CoV-2 variants.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Rockefeller Foundation and University of Wisconsin-Madison to focus on conducting genomic surveillance for SARS-CoV-2 in the school-aged children population to better understand the emergence and spread of SARS-CoV-2 variants; and

Whereas, The continued operation of this grant program from 06.01.2021 to 05.31.2022 would cost \$25,846
