THE CHAIR

An ordinance relating to waivers of storm water management plan requirements.

120-7-4-c-0 am

The code currently provides that the city engineer may grant a waiver from storm water management plan requirements for a particular development if the development is not likely to:

- Increase the rate or volume of storm water runoff.
- b. Have an adverse impact on a wetland, watercourse or receiving body of water.
- c. Contribute to the degradation of water quality.
- d. Otherwise impair attainment of the objectives of the city's storm water management regulations.

This ordinance adds the requirement that the development for which the waiver is requested must be primarily a storm water reduction or green infrastructure project.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 120-7-4-c-0 of the code is amended to read:

120-7. Control of Storm Water Discharge.
