This substitute resolution approves Year 2022 Operating Plans for Business Improvement District Nos. 2, 4, 5, 8, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 25, 26, 27, 28, 31, 32, 35, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 43, 48, 49, 50 and 51, and authorizes assessments on taxable property within said Districts.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council") has created Business Improvement Districts ("BIDs") in the City of Milwaukee and has approved their Initial Operating Plans; and

Whereas, Section 66.1109(3)(b), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that Boards of BIDs submit annual Operating Plans to the Common Council for approval; and

Chavez), 39 (Center Street Marketplace), 40 (Airport Gateway), 41 (Historic Downer Avenue), 43 (South 27 Street), 48 (Granville), 49 (Reed Street Yards), 50 (Crisol Corridor) and 51 (Harbor District) have submitted proposed Year 2022 Operating Plans; now, therefore, be it
