Substitute resolution directing the Department of Public Works to conduct a dockless motorized scooter pilot study.

This resolution directs the Department of Public Works to conduct a dockless motorized scooter pilot study. The pilot study will run until December 31, 2023 unless otherwise reauthorized by the Common Council. The Commissioner of Public Works will evaluate the results and effectiveness of the pilot and provide a report to the Common Council upon conclusion of the study.

Whereas, The Department of Public Works conducted dockless motorized scooter pilot studies in 2019 and 2021; and

Whereas, Based on the findings and results of the 2019 and 2021 dockless motorized scooter pilot studies, the Department of Public Works recommended continuing to allow dockless scooters in Milwaukee to better understand the usefulness, effectiveness, and safe operation of dockless motorized scooters; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council and the City of Milwaukee, that the Department of Public Works is directed to conduct a third dockless motorized scooter pilot study; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the dockless motorized scooter pilot study shall end on December 31, 2023, unless otherwise reauthorized by the Common Council; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works shall submit a final report on the results and effectiveness of dockless motorized scooters in the city, upon conclusion of the pilot study.
