## 8th Aldermanic District

35<sup>th</sup> Street Viaduct over the Menomonee River (BR100220106) File Number 211601: Repairs to existing bridge substructure and expansion joint at Pier 40. (City Share Non-assessable Structure Fund - additional funds \$100,000). The total estimated cost for this project including the requested amount is \$400,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction

Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$660,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$685,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2022 construction season.

W. Bottsford Ave.- 255' West of S. 68th St. to S. 72nd St. (WT410170604) File Number 151521: Relaying water main. (Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 5010 -- \$0. Nonassessable Water Fund Budget Line 6410 -- \$310,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$330,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.
