Resolution determining it necessary to make various nonassessable public improvements at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City engineering cost estimated to be \$175,000 for a total estimated cost of these projects being \$1,220,000.

This resolution authorizes engineering studies on projects which by City Charter are nonassessable. After design plans and estimates of costs have been prepared, a resolution authorizing construction will be submitted to the Common Council. The City cost for engineering these projects is estimated to be \$175,000 with the total cost estimated to be \$1,220,000.

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it is necessary and in the public interest to do the following described improvements according to City specifications:

2nd Aldermanic District

W. Fond Du Lac Ave. - N. 76th St. to W. Silver Spring Dr. (SM499220006) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$160,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

13th Aldermanic District

S. 13th St. - W. Boden Ct. to Airport Spur (SM499220004) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable

Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$140,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

S. 27th St. - W. College Ave. to W. Ramsey Ave. (SM499220003) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$200,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

W. Boden St. - S. Howell Ave. to 880'+/- West of S. Howell Ave. (SM499220005) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$100,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

W. Kinnickinnic River Pkwy. - S. 20th St. to S. 27th St. (SM499220007) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$300,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

W. Van Beck Ave. - S. 20th St. to W. Howard Ave. (SM499220009) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$200,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.

Jewell Playfield- Area Bounded By S. 17th St., S. 19th St., W. Wood Ave., and W. Jewell Ave. (SM499220002) Installing Bioswales. (Nonassessable Water Quality Fund -- \$25,000). The total estimated cost of this project including the requested amount is \$120,000. This project is anticipated to be completed during the 2023 construction season.
