THE CHAIR

Substitute resolution relative to acceptance and funding of the 2022-2023 Preventive Health Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to accept, and fund the 2022-2023 Preventive Health Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services in the amount of \$57,839 with a City share of \$0 and a grantor share of \$57,839. The funding will provide support for the Health Department's Community Health assessment and planning work, and staff training to facilitate community health planning and engagement.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) to fund preventive health and community health planning activities; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant program from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023 will cost \$57,839 comprised of \$57,839, or 100% grantor share and \$0, or 0% City share; now, therefore, be it;

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, that the Commissioner of Health or their designee is authorized to execute the grant agreement for these funds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant parent account of the 2022 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the project titled Preventive Health
