THE CHAIR

An ordinance relating to the amendment of the Official Map of the City of Milwaukee.

113-32.0121

The adoption of this ordinance will update the Official Map of the City of Milwaukee.

Whereas, The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

There is hereby added to the City of Milwaukee Code a new section to read as follows:

Section 113-32.0121 the Official Map, as mentioned and provided for in Section 113-32, is hereby amended so as to include the following additions as shown in the report on file in the City Clerk's office.

2ND ALDERMANIC DISTRICT N.E. 1/4 Sec. 34, T.8N., R.21E. Official Map Atlas Page 189

1. Alley in the block bounded by West Birch Avenue, West Sheridan Avenue, North 60<sup>th</sup> Street and North 62<sup>nd</sup> Street. The opening of a 28-foot wide north-south alley, right-of-way.

4TH ALDERMANIC DISTRICT S.W. 1/4 Sec. 29, T.7N., R.22E. Official Map Atlas Page 398 1. North 8<sup>th</sup> Street from West Michigan Street south to its terminus. The vacation of a variable width street right-of-way.

2. North 8<sup>th</sup> Street (west side) from West Michigan Street south to a point. The sale of a triangular portion of excess State right-of-way.

3. North 9<sup>th</sup> Street from West Michigan Street south to its terminus. The vacation of a 60-foot wide street rightof-way.

4. West McAuley Place between North 8<sup>th</sup> Street and North 9<sup>th</sup> Street. The sale of excess State right-of way that is no longer necessary.

5. West McAuley Place between North 8<sup>th</sup> Street and North 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Repealing the ordinance naming West McAuley Place to the roadway that is no longer necessary.

1. East Corcoran Avenue from North Jackson Street to North Harbor Drive. The opening of an 80-foot wide street right-of-way.
