This resolution authorizes the return of real estate located at 2325 - 2327 N Sherman BLVD, in the 15th Aldermanic District, to its former owner, Sunny Sky Properties LLC Attn: Martin Bethke, under conditions imposed by s. 304-50 of the Code of Ordinances.

Whereas, The property located at 2325 - 2327 N Sherman BLVD, previously owned by Sunny Sky Properties LLC Attn: Martin Bethke, has delinquent taxes for 2021-2023 and was foreclosed upon pursuant to Sec. 75.521, Wis. Stats., and a fee simple absolute was obtained in favor of the City of Milwaukee dated November 6, 2023 231558; and

Whereas, Sunny Sky Properties LLC Attn: Martin Bethke would like to reclaim said property by paying all City and County real estate taxes, plus accrued interest and penalties to date of payment, and all costs as sustained by the City in the foreclosing and management of said property since November 6, 2023; and

Whereas, Sunny Sky Properties LLC Attn: Martin Bethke has agreed to pay all related city charges up until the point that the property is returned, as well as all other charges, and conditions which are detailed in the letters submitted by the Department of Neighborhood Services, Department of City Development, the Health Department, the Treasurer’s Office, and the City Attorney’s Office, as though set forth in this resolution; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that in order to return the property at 2325 - 2327

N Sherman BLVD, a cashier's check must be submitted in the amount indicated by the City Treasurer within thirty 30 days of the adoption of this resolution; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Attorney is then authorized to enter into a stipulation with the former owner to reopen and vacate the City's judgment in Milwaukee County Circuit Court Case No 23-CV-5116. Known as the 2023-3 In Rem Parcel 123, securing the court's order and recording said order with the Milwaukee County Register of Deeds; and, be it

Further Resolved, That if the current levy-year installment taxes and all prior levy-year delinquent taxes inclusive of accrued interest and penalties due through the month of payment, plus all related City charges incurred through date of payment, are not paid within 30 days of the adoption of this resolution, this process becomes null and void.
