THE CHAIR

A substitute ordinance relating to ambulance conveyance rates.

75-15-14-c-1 am

75-15-14-c-2 am

This ordinance adjusts the rates charged by ambulances for patient services. For patients who are residents of the city of Milwaukee, for basic life support and for basic life support - emergency the charge is increased from \$441 to \$471. If they require treatment without transport the charge is increased from \$105 to \$112. For patients who are not residents of the city of Milwaukee, for basic life support and for basic life support - emergency the charge is increased from \$510 to \$545. If they require treatment without transport the charge is increased from \$150 to \$160.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

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Part 1. Section 75-15-14-c-1 and 2 of the code is amended to read:

75-15. Ambulance Certification Regulations.

- 14. DETERMINING RATES BILLED BY PRIVATE SECTOR PROVIDERS.
- c-1. For patients who are residents of the city of Milwaukee, for basic life support, [[\$441]] >> \$471 << and, for basic life support emergency, [[\$441]] >> \$471 <<. When patients require treatment without transport, a [[\$105]] >> \$112 << basic life support non-transport fee shall apply.
- c-2. For patients who are not residents of the city of Milwaukee, for basic life support, [[\$510]] >> \$545 << and, for basic life support emergency, [[\$510]] >> \$545 <<. When patients require treatment without transport, a [[\$150]] >> \$160 << basic life support non-transport fee shall apply.
