ALD. PÉREZ

A substitute ordinance relating to the sequence of appointments to plural bodies.

320-3.5 cr

This ordinance requires that appointments of individuals to plural bodies fill all specialized vacancies before filling general vacancies.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 320-3.5 of the code is created to read:

**320-3.5. Sequence of Appointments.** Except as otherwise provided by state law, whenever an appointing authority may make multiple appointments to a plural body, it shall appoint a specialized appointee before appointing a general appointee. A specialized appointee is a plural body member whose qualifications require one or more specific credentials, experiences, interests, or skills under the ordinance or statute governing said body. A general appointee is a plural body member whose qualifications do not require specific credentials, experiences, interests, or skills.
