Substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Blood Center of Wisconsin Flu Grant.

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the Blood Center of Wisconsin Flu Grant from the Blood Research Institute of the Blood Center of Wisconsin in the amount of \$100,000 provided by the grantor. The purpose of the project is to participate in a study of how the immune system responds to a virus traveling through the population

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Blood Center of Wisconsin Flu Grant from the Blood Research Institute of the Blood Center of Wisconsin; and

is, The operation of this grant project from 10/1/10 to 9/30/11 would cost \$100,000 provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Blood Research Institute of the Blood Center of Wisconsin is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Code of Ordinances Section 304-81; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2010 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Funds, the following amount for the project titled Blood Center of Wisconsin Flu Grant:

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Grantor Share
\$100,000

2. Create the necessary Special Revenue Fund - Grant and Aid Project/Grant and Project Grant Levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted to the Health Department which is authorized to:

- 1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;
- 2. Expend from the 2010 grant budget funds for training and out-of-town travel by departmental staff;
- 3. Enter into leases and subcontracts as detailed in the grant budget; and
- 4. Expend from the 2010 grant funds for equipment as deemed necessary for program operation.
