Whereas, There are a number of federal legislative proposals which are of importance to the City of Milwaukee; and

Whereas, These proposals were created as a result of suggestions by city departments, Common Council members and the Mayor; and

Whereas, These proposals were reviewed and approved by the Judiciary and Legislation Committee at its meeting of December 13, 2010; and

Whereas, The attached list of proposals reflects the action by the Judiciary and Legislation Committee at its December 13, 2010 meeting as the nucleus of the City's 2011 Federal Legislative Package; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it hereby endorses and adopts the attached Federal Legislative Agenda, attached to this file as though it were part of this file as the basis for the 2011 Federal Legislative Package, with the understanding that said package may later be expanded or reduced by resolution of the Common Council as need arises; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Division of Intergovernmental Relations be and hereby is directed to seek introduction of these proposals or otherwise seek to accomplish approval of these items in the 2011 session of Congress and to use its best efforts in support of said legislation.
