### THE CHAIR

A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls.

This ordinance establishes the above-mentioned parking requirements in various parts of the City.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 101-23-2 of the Code relating to No Stopping is amended by adding the following:

On the south side of West Lincoln Avenue from South 38<sup>th</sup> Street to a point 255 feet west

Part 2. Section 101-23-3 of the Code relating to No Parking is amended by adding the following:

In the alley bounded by West Blue Mound Road, West St Paul Avenue, North 91<sup>st</sup> Street and North 92<sup>nd</sup> Street

Part 3. Section 101-23-4-d of the Code relating to Two-Hour Parking is amended by striking the following:

“On the north side of W. Dakota Street from S. 31<sup>st</sup> Street to S. 33<sup>rd</sup> Street from 7:00 am to 5:00 pm except Saturday and Sunday”

“On West Dakota Street from South 33<sup>rd</sup> Street to South 34<sup>th</sup> Street, Except Saturday and Sunday”

“On South 34<sup>th</sup> Street from West Manitoba Street to West Oklahoma Avenue”

Part 5. Section 101-23-4-d of the Code relating to Two-Hour Parking is amended by adding the following:

On the north side of East North Avenue from a point 230 feet west of North Cambridge Avenue to a point 350 feet west thereof
