Whereas, It has been proposed by the Department of City Development that the unimproved pedestrian way in the block between North 98th Street and North Menomonee River Parkway, north of West Center Street, be vacated pursuant to the provisions of Section 62.73, Wisconsin Statutes; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the Department of City Development is directed to prepare a resolution to vacate said unimproved pedestrian way in accordance with Section 308-28 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
