### THE CHAIR

Resolution relative to application, acceptance, and funding of a Speed Enforcement 2011-12 grant.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for, accept, and fund a Speed Enforcement grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety in the amount of \$60,000. The purpose of this grant is to detect and apprehend motor vehicle operators under the influence of an intoxicant or controlled substance.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for a Speed Enforcement grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, and

Whereas, The operation of this grant from 10/01/11 to 09/30/12 would cost \$60,000 of which 100% would be provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation is authorized and the Police Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Section 304-81, Milwaukee Code Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2011 Special Revenue-Grant and Aid Projects, the following amount for the program titled: Speed Enforcement 2011-12 Project Grant:
