Substitute resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of the Utilizing Peer Teen Advocates to Increase HPV Vaccination Rates in Adolescents Grant from the Healthier Wisconsin Partnership Program (Medical College of Wisconsin).

This resolution authorizes the Health Department to apply for, accept and fund the Utilizing Peer Teen Advocates to Increase HPV Vaccination Rates in Adolescents Grant from the Healthier Wisconsin Partnership Program (Medical College of Wisconsin) in the amount of \$58,862. The purpose of the project is to increase awareness and education of HPV Infection and ultimately increase HPV vaccination rates.

Whereas, The City of Milwaukee appears to be eligible for grant funds from the Utilizing Peer Teen Advocates to Increase HPV Vaccination Rates in Adolescents Grant from the Healthier Wisconsin Partnership Program (Medical College of Wisconsin) to increase awareness and education of HPV Infection and ultimately increase HPV vaccination rates; and

Whereas, The operation of this grant project from 01/01/12 to 12/31/13 would cost \$58,862 entirely provided by the grantor; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application to the Healthier Wisconsin Partnership Program (Medical College of Wisconsin) is authorized and the Health Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Milwaukee Ordinance 304-81; and, be it
