## THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing acceptance and funding of the 1999/2000 HIDTA project awards (Milwaukee Police Department). This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to continue its participation in a High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) project. The Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) will reimburse the City for 55% of salaries and fringe benefits, and 100% of overtime expenses for staff time contributed by the Milwaukee Police Department toward HIDTA efforts. This funding comes in the form of six separate grant awards, relating to the six task forces on which Police personnel participate.

Whereas, The Common Council in file 981170 approved funding for federal fiscal year 1999 for Police Department participation in the Milwaukee HIDTA project; and

Whereas, The Milwaukee Police Department's participation in the HIDTA project for federal fiscal year 2000 from October 1, 1999 to September 30, 2000 is expected to cost a total \$1,906,352, of which \$954,201 would be provided by the grantor and \$952,151 would be provided by the City; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that application for HIDTA is authorized and the Milwaukee Police Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council file 940843 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Comptroller of the City of Milwaukee is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 1999 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the HIDTA project:

2. Create the necessary Grant and Aids Project/Grant and Project/Grant Levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement; and

3. Establish the necessary City Share Project Values; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted for the Milwaukee Police Department which is authorized to:

1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;

2. Transfer funds within the project budgets as long as the amount expended for each specific purpose does not exceed the amount authorized by budget by 10 percent; and

3. Enter into subcontracts and leases as detailed in the grant budget; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the 1999 and 2000 positions Ordinances be amended as follows to reflect additional positions and related footnotes:

POLICE DEPARTMENT VICE CONTROL Detective (K) +2

(K) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant. Position authority to expire if HIDTA funding and the HIDTA project are discontinued. Police JP
