THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing acceptance and funding of the 2006 HIDTA project awards.

This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to continue its participation in a High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) project. The Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) will reimburse the City for 41% of salaries and fringe benefits, and 100% of overtime expenses for staff time contributed by the Milwaukee Police Department toward HIDTA efforts. This funding comes in the form of five separate grant awards, relating to the five task forces on which Police personnel participate.

Whereas, The Common Council in file 041284 approved funding for federal fiscal year 2005 for Police Department participation in the Milwaukee HIDTA project; and

Whereas, The Milwaukee Police Department's participation in the HIDTA project for the period of January 1, 2006 to December 31, 2006 would cost \$1,867,823 of which \$992,541 (53%) would be provided by the grantor and \$875,282 (47%) would be provided by the City; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that application for HIDTA is authorized and the Milwaukee Police Department shall accept this grant without further approval unless the terms of the grant change as indicated in Common Council File 030712 (Grant Ordinance); and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Comptroller of the City of Milwaukee is authorized to:

1. Commit funds within the Project/Grant Parent of the 2006 Special Revenue Grant and Aid Projects Fund, the following amounts for the HIDTA project:

2. Create the necessary Grant and Aids Project/Grant and Project/Grant levels; budget against these Project/Grant values the amounts required under the grant agreement;

3. Establish the necessary City Share Project Values; and, be it

Further Resolved, That these funds are budgeted for the Milwaukee Police Department which is authorized to:

1. Expend from the amount budgeted sums for specified purposes as indicated in the grant budget and incur costs consistent with the award date;

2. Transfer funds within the project budgets as long as the amount expended for each specific purpose does not exceed the amount authorized by budget by 10 percent; and
3. Enter into subcontracts and leases as detailed in the grant budget; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the 2006 Positions Ordinance be amended as follows to reflect the change in footnote (K):

(K) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant. Position authority to expire if HIDTA funding and the HIDTA project are discontinued or until 12/31/06 unless the HIDTA grant is extended.
