## THE CHAIR

Resolution authorizing and directing a transfer of funds from the Capital Improvements Planning Account to two subaccounts for residential, commercial, and economic development analysis activities and other technical planning studies. (DCD)

This resolution transfers \$25,000 in funds from the Capital Improvements Planning Account into two subaccounts: \$12,500 into the Planning Studies-Economic Development Subaccount No. UR01280028 and \$12,500 into the Special Engineering and Technical Studies Subaccount No. UR01280041. Each subaccount allocation will provide consultant assistance on studies of housing, commercial and residential developments, and land use as well as other technical planning studies as the need arises.

Whereas, The Department of City Development continues work on neighborhood residential and commercial analysis and development as well as land use policy development; and

Whereas, Technical assistance in these planning activities has often been provided by outside consultants; and

Whereas, Funds are necessary to provide for such consultant services as the need arises; and

Whereas, The current unencumbered balances in the Planning Studies-Economic Development Subaccount and the Special Engineering and Technical Studies Subaccount are insufficient to cover anticipated 2000 needs; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the City Comptroller is authorized and directed to transfer the amount of \$25,000 from the Capital Improvements Planning Account, Account No. UR01280000, to be allocated to two existing subaccounts Planning Studies-Economic Development, Account No. UR01280028, \$12,500, and Special Engineering and Technical Studies, Account No. UR01280041, \$12,500, to be used by the Department of City Development, as the need may arise, to support residential and commercial analyses and land use policy development; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of City Development is authorized and directed to enter into such contracts and agreements as necessary to accomplish the intent and purpose of this resolution.
