Resolution authorizing the issuance of a street occupancy permit to Reichl Construction for work at the Third District Police Station at 2333 N. 49th Street.

This resolution authorizes City officials to issue a street occupancy permit to Reichl Construction, allowing them to occupy portions of North 49th Street, North 50th Street, and the east/west alley, all immediately adjacent to the Third District Police Station at 2333 N. 49th Street.

Whereas, Reichl Construction has requested permission to occupy portions of North 49th Street, North 50th Street and the east/west alley, all immediately adjacent to the Third District Police Station at 2333 N. 49th Street; and

Whereas, Reichl Construction has indicated that they need this area to undertake work on the Third District Police Station between mid-June and mid-July 2016; and

Whereas, The Commissioner of Public Works may approve temporary occupancy of up to one-third of the width of the roadway while temporary use beyond that point must be approved by the Common Council; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to issue a permit to Reichl Construction, Inc., and the BCSEC, allowing occupancy of the entire roadways of North 49th Street, North 50th Street, and the east/west alley, all immediately adjacent to the Third District Police Station at 2333 N. 49th Street from mid-June to mid-July 2016.
