Whereas, The Certified Planning Board of Standards, the Financial Planning Association, the Foundation for Financial Planning and the U.S. Conference of Mayors have formed a consortium to promote the national effort "Financial Planning Days"; and

Whereas, The objectives of Financial Planning Days are to help people experience first-hand how financial planning can improve their lives and to bring expertise of professional financial planners to persons who may not normally have access to reliable and ethical financial planning information; and

Whereas, These organizations, in partnership with the City of Milwaukee, the Financial Planning Association of Southern Wisconsin and local certified financial planners, are sponsoring no-cost, one-on-one financial counseling on October 22, 2016; and
