Substitute resolution relating to a Minor Modification to a Detailed Planned Development known as Hotel of the Arts Days Inn to permit additional hotel rooms and an outdoor patio at the Hotel of the Arts Days Inn and Suites at 1840 North 6th Street, located on the east side of North 6th Street, south of West Reservoir Avenue, in the 6th Aldermanic District.

This Minor Modification was requested by Jackson Center, LLC and will permit conversion of meeting room space at Hotel of the Arts into additional guest rooms and the addition of an outdoor patio.

Whereas, Section 295-907-2(i) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances permits minor modifications to planned developments after approval of the Common Council; and

Whereas, The detailed plan for a planned development ("DPD") known as Hotel of the Arts Days Inn, located on the east side of North 6th Street, south of West Reservoir Avenue, was approved by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee on September 25, 2007 under File No. 070496; and

Whereas, The minor modification to Hotel of the Arts Days Inn to allow additional hotel rooms and an outdoor patio is consistent with the spirit and intent of the approved plan and will not adversely affect the surrounding development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that the minor modification:

- 1. Is consistent with the spirit and intent of the previously approved DPD.
- 2. Will not change the general character of the DPD.
- 3. Will not cause a substantial relocation of principal or accessory structures.
- 4. Will not cause a substantial relocation or reduction of parking, loading or recreation areas.
- 5. Will not cause a substantial relocation of traffic facilities.
- 6. Will not increase the land coverage of buildings and parking areas.
- 7. Will not increase the gross floor area of buildings or the number of dwelling units.
- 8. Will not reduce the amount of approved open space, landscaping or screening; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the minor modification is approved in accordance with the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, Section 295-907-2(i).
