### 170533 SUBSTITUTE 1

#### ALD. KOVAC AND PEREZ

A substitute ordinance relating to overnight parking.

This ordinance:

1. Eliminates the 4-inch snow parking rule throughout the city.
2. Eliminates the requirement for alternate side parking throughout aldermanic district 12, except when the department of public works announces snow-plowing operations or other public works operations are underway.
3. Extends the hours when properly permitted vehicles are required to comply with alternate side overnight parking regulations, which are now 2 a.m. until 6 a.m., to 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. the following day whenever the department of public works announces snow-plowing operations or other public works operations are underway.
4. Provides for a \$40 citation for violations of overnight parking regulations whenever the department of public works announces snow-plowing operations or other public works operations are underway.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 101-26.5 of the code is repealed.

Part 2. Section 101-27-1-a-2-f of the code is amended to read:

#### **101-27. All Night Parking**

##### **1. RESTRICTIONS**

a-2-f. N. 16th St., Menomonee River, Milwaukee River, Kinnickinnic River, W. Becher St., S. 6th St., W. Hayes St., S. 10th St., W. Cleveland Ave., S. 14th St., railroad right of way, S. 20th St., W. Rogers St., S. 19th St., W. Mitchell St., S. 20th St., W. Pierce St., S. 16<sup>th</sup> St. ~~[[, and exempted from alternate side parking by sub. 3-b-1.]]~~

Part 3. Section 101-27-1-b-2 of the code is amended to read:

b-2. The hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. the following day ~~[[in designated parking areas described in subd. a-2]]~~ when the department of public works announces snow-plowing operations or other public

works operations are underway, except as otherwise restricted or permitted in this section.

Part 4. Section 101-27-2-a of the code is amended to read:

**2. SPECIAL PERMIT.**

a. A vehicle may be parked between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m., or between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. the following day ~~[[in designated parking areas described in sub. 1-a-2]]~~ when the department of public works announces snow-plowing operations or other public works operations are underway, provided a special privilege permit for the vehicle is first obtained online or from any facility the city may designate for the sale of such permit, after filing an application and paying a permit fee, all as required under this section, and shall be parked as authorized by such permit, as provided in sub. 5.

Part 5. Section 101-34-2-a of the code is amended to read:

**101-34. Stipulation or Contestation**

**2. FORFEITURE SCHEDULE**

a. Citations issued for violation of ss. 101-27 except sub. 1-a, >>1-b-2,<< 4 and 7-d; and s 101-24.7-2-b: \$20.

Part 6. Section 101-34-2-g of the code is repealed and recreated to read:

g. Citations issued for violation of ss. 101-23-9-a-3, 101-23.5, 101-26.7, 101-27-1-a and 101-27-1-b-2: \$40.
