Substitute resolution relative to legislative bills.

Whereas, The Judiciary and Legislation Committee of the Common Council has recommended the following positions on the bills hereinafter listed and the Common Council being advised of said matters; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, that it hereby approves the following legislative bills and instructs the Division of Intergovernmental Relations to appear before the proper committees to support such bills and use its best endeavors to have the same enacted into law, viz:

--- LRB-0074

Relating to: the creation of an independent use of force review advisory board.

--- LRB-0075

Relating to: law enforcement agency policies on the use of force.

---LRB-1232

Relating to: tracking of sexual assault kits in sexual assault cases, granting rule-making authority, and making an appropriation.

--- LRB-1500

Relating to: dentists administering certain vaccines.

Further Resolved, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee is opposed to the following legislative bills and hereby instructs the Division of Intergovernmental Relations to appear before the proper committees in opposition to said bills and use its best endeavors in opposition to the same viz:

--- LRB-0158

Relating to: boards of police and fire commissioners and protective services departments in populous cities.

--- LRB-0837/1

Relating to: alcohol beverages delivery and the face-to-face requirement for retail sales of alcohol beverages.

Further Resolved, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee has no position with respect to the following, but the Intergovernmental Relations Division is directed to seek an amendment allowing municipalities to choose whether or not to permit this practice.

--- LRB-1338/1

Relating to: the retail sale of intoxicating liquor by the glass for consumption away from the licensed premises.
